**Method of Judging:** Horses/ponies will enter the ring individually and jump a course of obstacles designed to produce a maximum of 8 jumping efforts. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 – at the judges' discretion. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out but three refusals will result in elimination. Fall of horse or rider will result in elimination. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placings.

**Direct qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2016 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.** Open to members and non-members purchasing day membership for this show. Day membership must be purchased from VHS head office in advance of the show, at a cost of £15. A day membership card and age badge will be provided. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. Members and day members must carry their current VHS membership card **in the ring** and produce these on request – no exceptions will be made.

**VHS Regional Final qualification.** All competitors placed first to fourth in each class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members and Day-members will have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Day-members must become full VHS members within 14 days and exchange their day-showing card for a full showing card in order to validate their Regional Final qualification. Regional Finals are open to members only.

**VHS Supreme Final qualification.** Competitors placed first and second in each class will also qualify directly for the corresponding class at the VHS Supreme Final, to be held at the National Veteran Open Championships, Bury Farm, Buckinghamshire, 23-25 September. If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line **on the day**. Day members must become full VHS members in order to enter the Supreme Final.

**VHS M&M Supreme Final qualification.** The highest placed M&M in each class will qualify for the VHS M&M Supreme Final at the National Veteran Open Championships.

**Young Rider Championship qualification.** A Young Rider rosette and qualification will be awarded to the young rider of the Judge's choice, entitling them to enter the Young Rider Championship at the National Veteran Open Championships. This award is given at the Judge's discretion. All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Open Championships, 23-25 September. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

<b>Class 65</b>	<b>IN HAND PIEBALD/SKEWBALD</b> Open in hand Piebald/Skewbald filly, mare or gelding, any height or age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. <b>This class is a qualifier for Equifest 2017 In Hand Piebald/Skewbald.</b>
<b>Class 66</b>	<b>IN-HAND YOUNGSTOCK</b> Filly or gelding, yearling, 2 or 3 years old. Open to all, any height.
<b>Class 67</b>	<b>IN-HAND HUNTER/RIDING HORSE TYPE</b> Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Open to all, any height.
<b>Class 68</b>	<b>IN-HAND MINIATURE PONY</b> Filly, mare or gelding, over one year old.
<b>Class 69</b>	<b>CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from Classes 64-68.</b>
<b>Class 70</b>	<b>RIDDEN THELWELL – Fun Class</b> Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Open to all.
<b>Class 71</b>	<b>FANCY DRESS – Fun Class - <i>Kindly sponsored by Mr Roy Barker</i></b> Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Open to all, any height.

# **SUFFOLK AGRICULTURAL ASSOCIATION AUTUMN SHOW**

## **BY-LAWS**

### **1) Judging**

The Judges to commence their judging at the appointed time as shown in the order of the Show. The Judge's decision is final. The Association reserves the right to substitute other Judges for those mentioned in the schedule without notification to exhibitors and others.

### **2) Exhibitors**

All Exhibitors must be prepared to have their horses in the Showground ready to be judged at the appointed time. Those in charge of animals shall be subject to the orders of the Show Manager and Stewards of the show. No animal will be admitted to the showground without a proper halter. The organisers reserve the right to stop or prevent a horse or pony competing for whatever reason, at their discretion.

### **3) Protest**

In all cases of disputed awards, the protest, in writing, shall be made to the Secretary within an hour of delivering such award. The person protesting shall at the same time of making the protest deposit with the Secretary the sum of £25.00. The same shall be returned to the party protesting if the protest is sustained and in the case of it not being sustained the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the Association. The Secretary, if possible, shall give notice of the protest to the person against whom it is made. The Secretary and Show Manager shall, if possible, decide the case that day, otherwise it shall be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be binding and conclusive on all parties and no action at law shall be brought or maintained in respect thereof. No member of the Committee or Steward shall take part in the settlement of the disputed Award for which he is a competitor.

### **4) Hard Hats**

It is mandatory for **All** riders (including judges) to wear a protective helmet manufactured to conform to current approved BSI or European Standard. Such headgear must be worn with a chinstrap correctly and securely fastened at all times whilst mounted on the showground. The Association accepts no responsibility or liability for any injury arising from failure to comply with this regulation.

### **5) Car Parks**

Motor cars, lorries, coaches, motor cycles and cycles admitted will be left along with contents entirely at owner's risk.

### **6) Entry Fees**

The SAA reserves the right not to accept an entry. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is produced in respect of the horse or a doctor's certificate in respect of the exhibitor or rider. There will be a compulsory first aid charge of £2.00 per exhibitor.

### **7) Lost Children**

Children who become separated from their parents or carers should be taken to the secretary's office and a member of staff informed.

### **8) Dogs**

Dogs are allowed on the Showground but must be kept on leads at all times. Please clean up after your dog.

9) **Veterinary assistance**

A Veterinary officer will be on call. Exhibitors are liable for any costs incurred from treatment by the veterinary officers.

10) The organisers reserve the right to split/amalgamate classes at their discretion.

11) The organisers reserve the right to amend, cancel or change any class in the schedule.

12) The horse walk must be used to access the Grand and Trinity rings. Exercise kept to the collecting rings only, no horses/ponies permitted in the public areas.

13) Lunging is strictly prohibited on the showground.

14) No litter to be left anywhere and mucking out of horseboxes and trailers on the showground is strictly prohibited.

15) No stallions permitted on the showground.

16) **Disclaimer of Liability**

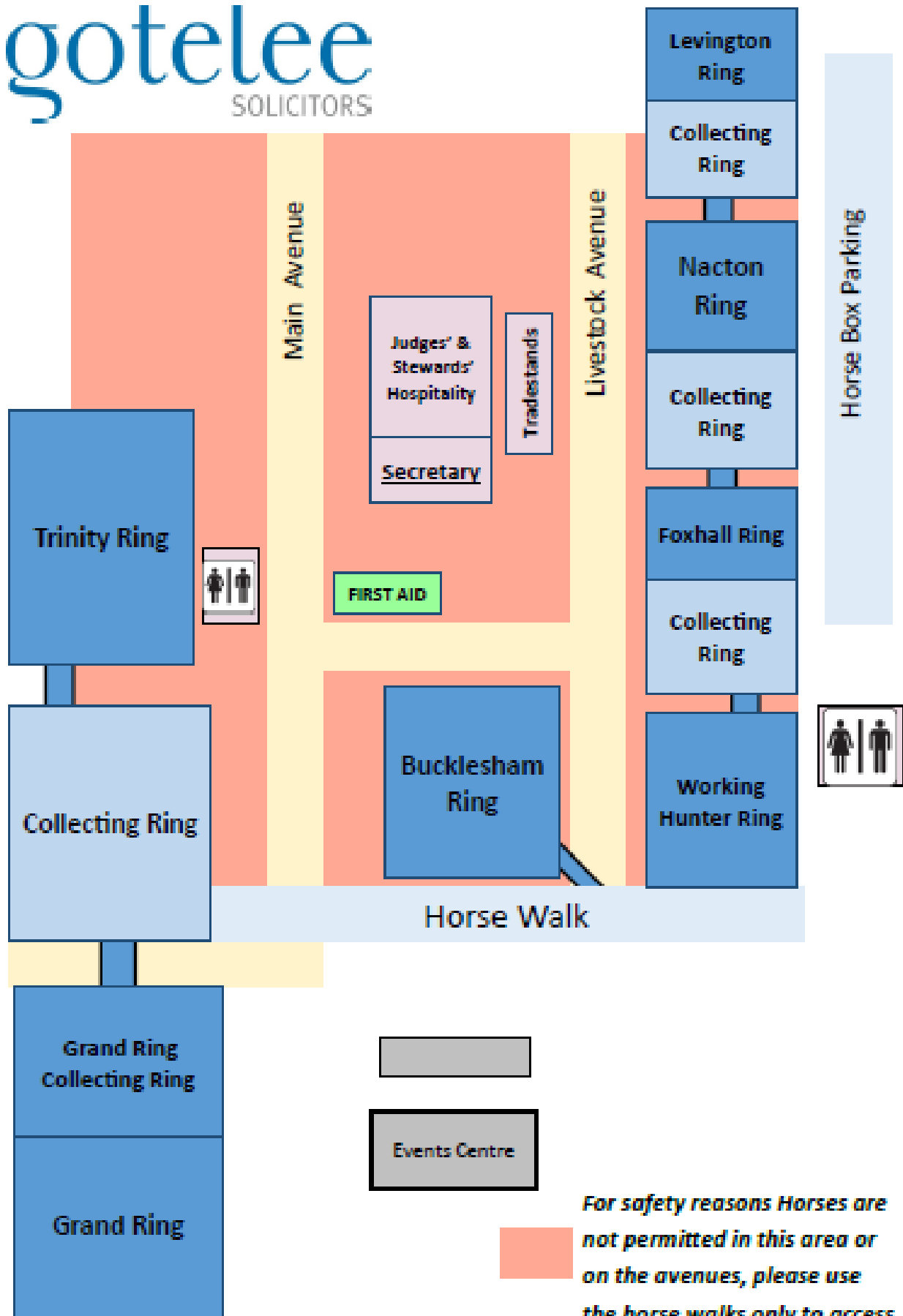
The Association, its officers or employees will not be responsible for or accountable to any person whatsoever for any damage or loss to the property of any person whatsoever or for any accident or injury fatal or otherwise or for any disease damage or loss that may occur to any person excepting only death or personal injury arising directly from the negligence of the Association its Council, officers or employees, whilst upon the showground or car parks or whilst entering or leaving the same.

Excepting only the case of death or personal injury arising directly from the negligence of the Association its officers or employees, the said Association its officers or employees will not be responsible under any circumstances whatsoever for any accident loss or damage that may occur to or be caused by any animal article or vehicle exhibited or brought on to the showground or car parks. Save as aforesaid each exhibitor or competitor shall be held solely responsible for any accident loss injury or damage that may occur to or be caused by any animal article vehicle or property exhibited or brought on to the showground or car parks by the exhibitor or competitor and that exhibitor or competitor shall indemnify the Association against any damages or claims whatsoever and any legal proceedings arising. Acceptance of the foregoing provisions shall be a condition of entry. Exhibitors shall be held liable for the behaviour and for any misconduct or negligence of their employees or contractors.

The Association insists that all exhibitors have in place their own appropriate insurance to cover all risks and liabilities not only as regards their own property but also in respect of any third party claim.

The Association reserves to itself by its Council or with the authority of that body the Chairman of the Executive the sole and absolute right to interpret these or any other prescribed conditions and regulations and arbitrarily to settle and determine all matters questions or differences in regard thereto or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to the Show. Also to refuse and to cancel any entries and relax any conditions or regulations as the Association may deem expedient.

The Association reserves the right to postpone cancel abandon or curtail the Show. Where such decision arises from direct happenings or circumstances outside the control of the Association the Association shall not accept liability for any consequential loss, financial or otherwise arising thereby, nor for the refund of any fees and charges paid.
