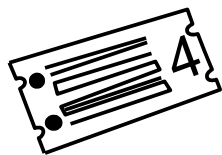

## Car Parking

There is parking for blue badge holders at the front of all of the car parks. **When you arrive please make it clear to the car parking stewards that you require parking within this area and they will be pleased to direct you there.**

Please note that early admission is advisable.



## Toilets

Wheelchair accessible toilets are available in all toilet blocks. Please note that many of them are unisex and that the Stockman's Canteen toilets are only accessible from the inside. Accessible toilets do not require a RADAR key.



## Baby Changing Facilities

There are baby changing facilities in all of the toilet blocks and there is a private room within the 'Nacton toilet block', which is situated along Sixteenth avenue.

Under 5's Change and Play (next to the Bucklesham Ring, along Seventh Avenue) welcomes parents to go in and change / feed their babies etc.

# Hospitality Centre for Disabled People

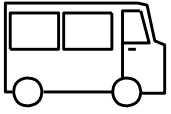


A dedicated hospitality area and meeting point for disabled people and their carers is situated at

**Stand Red 430.** Refreshments are available at a

nominal charge. This area is also housing a private changing area with a disabled hoist and adjustable bed.

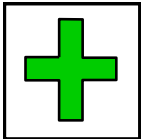
The centre is organised and managed by Easton & Otley College.



## **Courtesy Buggies**

There will be three 10 seater courtesy buggies, operating between 9.00am and 5.30pm on each day, that are for the use of disabled visitors and senior citizens who need help to travel around the Showground.

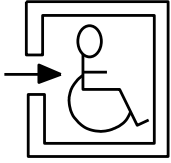
The buggies will travel on a set route around the Showground and will stop at various drop off points. Please see the map for details of the route.



## **First Aid**

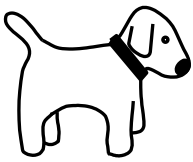
St Johns Ambulance, the Red Cross and doctors will be providing first aid. There are two first aid points and they are situated in the following places:

- 1) Stand No Blue 369 – Next to the Foxhall Entrance.
- 2) Stand No Green 976 – Seventh Avenue, in between the Farm Discovery Zone and the Bucklesham Ring



## **Ring Viewing Areas**

The Grand Ring, Trinity Ring and the President's Ring all have specific viewing areas for disabled people. These are designed to help you to enjoy the Ring action.



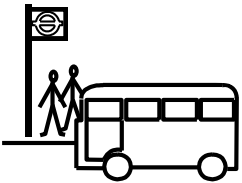
## **Assistance Dogs**

## **Hard Roads**

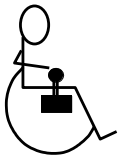
There are many hard road avenues across the showground to help with ease of mobility. The grass avenues are still mainly accessible due to the showground being relatively flat and free draining, but due to the size of the showground self propelling a manual wheelchair is not advised.

# Mobility Scooter/Wheelchair Hire

Event Mobility Charitable Trust will be providing electric scooters and manual wheelchairs for the use of disabled, elderly and mobility impaired visitors to the show.
