Enjoy country life at the show

Embrace what the Suffolk Show is all about

10.15am Wednesday - admire the heavy horses

Immerse yourself in the spirit of the Suffolk Show by heading over to the Grand Ring to watch the Heavy Horse Turnouts.

This year, we have selected the iconic Suffolk Punch to help promote the event, using the critically endangered horses on posters and billboards.

You can visit the new Heavy Horse Village to see how the Suffolk Punch horses are prepared for the show ring, including having their manes plaited.

11am both days – judge the best cattle

The Bucklesham Ring is the place to be if you are looking to appreciate one of the more traditional events at the show, cattle judging.

On both days of the show you will be able to see some of the finest breeds of cow being judged. Amongst the favourites are the hairy Highland Cattle, which will be on display at 12pm on the Wednesday.

1.45pm Thursday – watch sheepdogs at work

After enjoying a spot of lunch at the food hall, or one of the many other tasty eateries on offer, make your way to the President's Ring.



Then sit back and admire, as sheepdogs and their owners show off their skills in front of the crowds.

3pm Thursday – see the best of what the Suffolk Show has to offer

Seen as one of the highlights, the Grand Parade showcases the show's award winners. Participants range from rosette winning sheep to immaculately groomed horses. It is certainly a great country life spectacle that will appeal to all ages. As you might expect, the Grand Parade takes place in the busy Grand Ring so make sure you get there early to grab the best vantage point. You can also watch the

parade at 4.15pm on the Wednesday.

4.30pm Wednesday – parade of hounds

Nothing screams country life more than a classic Parade of Hounds. If you've been walking around the show and are lagging slightly, grab yourself a drink and head to the President's Ring to watch the parade. You will be experiencing a true snapshot of Suffolk's rural history.

Once you have replenished your energy, continue to soak up the atmosphere of this fantastic country show by having a look around the other parade rings and animal pens.
