

## REGULATIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) All entries are classed as exhibits and judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (Third Edition 2015), **copies may be obtained from NAFAS Enterprises, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, 42-44 Bishopsgate, London EC2N 4AH or [www.nafas.org.uk](http://www.nafas.org.uk) (Price £5.00).**
- 2) The Judges' decision shall be final.
- 3) All exhibits and exhibitors' property will be at the risk of the exhibitor and the Suffolk Agricultural Association accepts NO liability whatsoever for any loss or damage sustained by any exhibitor.
- 4) **Exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor and must be arranged in the marquee**, (with the exception of Classes 10,12 and 13 which may be brought ready assembled), between 12.00pm and 8.30pm on Tuesday 30 May 2023. Individual exhibitors will NOT be admitted to the marquee until 12.00pm. However, exhibitors in Class 1 (Clubs) will be admitted at 11.30am to ease congestion.
- 5) *Exhibits must remain on view until 6.00pm on Thursday 1 June 2023.*
- 6) Please note that on staging day, Tuesday 30 May 2023, food and drink will be available in the marquee.
- 7) At least seven days before the Show, confirmation of entries will be sent with a two-day Exhibitor's Badge, which must be worn whilst staging and during the Show, and a car pass which must be displayed on the windscreen at all times. Exhibitors' cars will be allowed onto the Showground via Gate 6 (Bucklesham Road) on Tuesday 30 May 2023 for staging and on Thursday 1 June 2023 between 4.00pm and 6.00pm, for collection of exhibits.
- 8) No perishable foods, with the exception of fresh fruit and vegetables, to be used in exhibits.
- 9) Mechanics, drapes, backgrounds etc MUST NOT be attached to the staging.
- 10) NO PHOTOGRAPHY during staging
- 11) Aerosol spray cans or other finishes MUST NOT be used in the marquee.
- 12) After judging, no exhibit may be touched by any exhibitor. During the Show, all exhibits will be in the care of the stewards who reserve the right to remove and/or replace any wilted plant material at their discretion.
- 13) Premiums and prize money will be posted to exhibitors after the Show.
- 14) Please help the stewards look after your exhibits by not completely filling containers with foam and leaving adequate space for water. Foam dries out quickly in marquee conditions and fresh plant material wilts rapidly, exhibitors are therefore advised to ensure that all fresh plant materials are in water or foam.
- 15) Please make every effort to stage exhibits for all classes entered as marquee space is costly; blank spaces spoil the overall effect of the Show and are disappointing for the visiting public.
- 16) The Association reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in any Class. It is therefore advisable to send entries early to avoid disappointment.
- 17) If there are five or less entries in any class the Association reserves the right to reduce the number of prizes awarded or withdraw the class, as deemed necessary.
- 18) ENTRIES CLOSE at 5.00pm on FRIDAY 7 APRIL 2023. If you require acknowledgment of receipt, please tick the relevant box on the entry form and enclose a stamped addressed envelope if necessary.
- 19) The Association shall have permission to do the following: a) store, process and retain, including electronically, all data and personal information provided by exhibitors, for the purposes of operating the Show, maintaining appropriate records and communicating with the exhibitor in future concerning any of the Association's activities; b) publicise the names and home locations of exhibitors, including but not limited to prize winners, in Show catalogues, on the Show website and elsewhere as part of the operation and promotion of the Show and future Shows; c) pass on the contact details of those who qualify for competitions/championships listed in the schedule to the competition organisers, where applicable, to enable them to make direct contact; d) photograph any exhibitor or other person on the showground and store and use the resulting image (including edited or altered versions) for any of the Association's commercial or non-commercial purposes in all and any media, including, without limitation, use in promotional materials and on the Association's website, or supply to carefully selected third parties for use for their own purposes. The Association shall own the copyright of any such images; d) publish the details and results of any disputes and/or appeals.

Craft class.

Space allowed 35cm wide, 30cm high, 10cm deep. To include loop for hanging.  
Background dark grey.

**This class is open to JUNIORS only, aged 5-11 years on 2 June 2023.**

**PRIZES: £14, £10, £8, £6**

## CLASS 13: FLY THE FLAG

Craft class.

Space allowed 35cm wide, 30cm high, 10cm deep. To include loop for hanging.  
Background dark grey.

**This class is open to JUNIORS only, aged 12-17 years on 2 June 2023.**

**PRIZES: £14, £10, £8, £6.**

**IMPORTANT, PLEASE NOTE: Depending on the number and age of entrants in classes 12 and 13, the age split between the two classes may be changed slightly to ensure an even distribution of entries.**
